**Below are some of the most commonly used examples of slang and colloquialisms in everyday conversations:**

**Gonna** = going to  
e.g. I'm gonna find a new job soon.

**Wanna** = want to  
e.g. I don't wanna do it now.

**Ain't** = isn't / aren't / haven't/ hasn't  
e.g. There ain't no party at John's this week-end.

**Gotcha** = got it = understand  
e.g. Gotcha now. Thanks for explaining that.

**Dunno** = don't know  
e.g. I dunno what you want from me.

**'cause/'cos/'coz** (American) = because  
e.g. He did it 'cause he loves you.

**Lemme** = let me  
e.g. Lemme say that again.

**Gimme** = Give me  
e.g. Gimme that book. It's mine.

**Gotta** = have got to  
e.g. Sorry but I gotta go now.

**Outta** = out of  
e.g. I don't like this place. Let's get outta here!

**Innit** / init/ in't = isn't it  
e.g. It's Pete's house, innit?

**Yeah** = yes  
e.g. Oh yeah, you're right.

**Yep** = yes  
e.g. Do you work at weekends? Yep.

**Nope** = no  
e.g. Are they a couple? - Nope, they're just friends.

**Nah** = no  
e.g. Do you need some help? – Nah, thanks.
